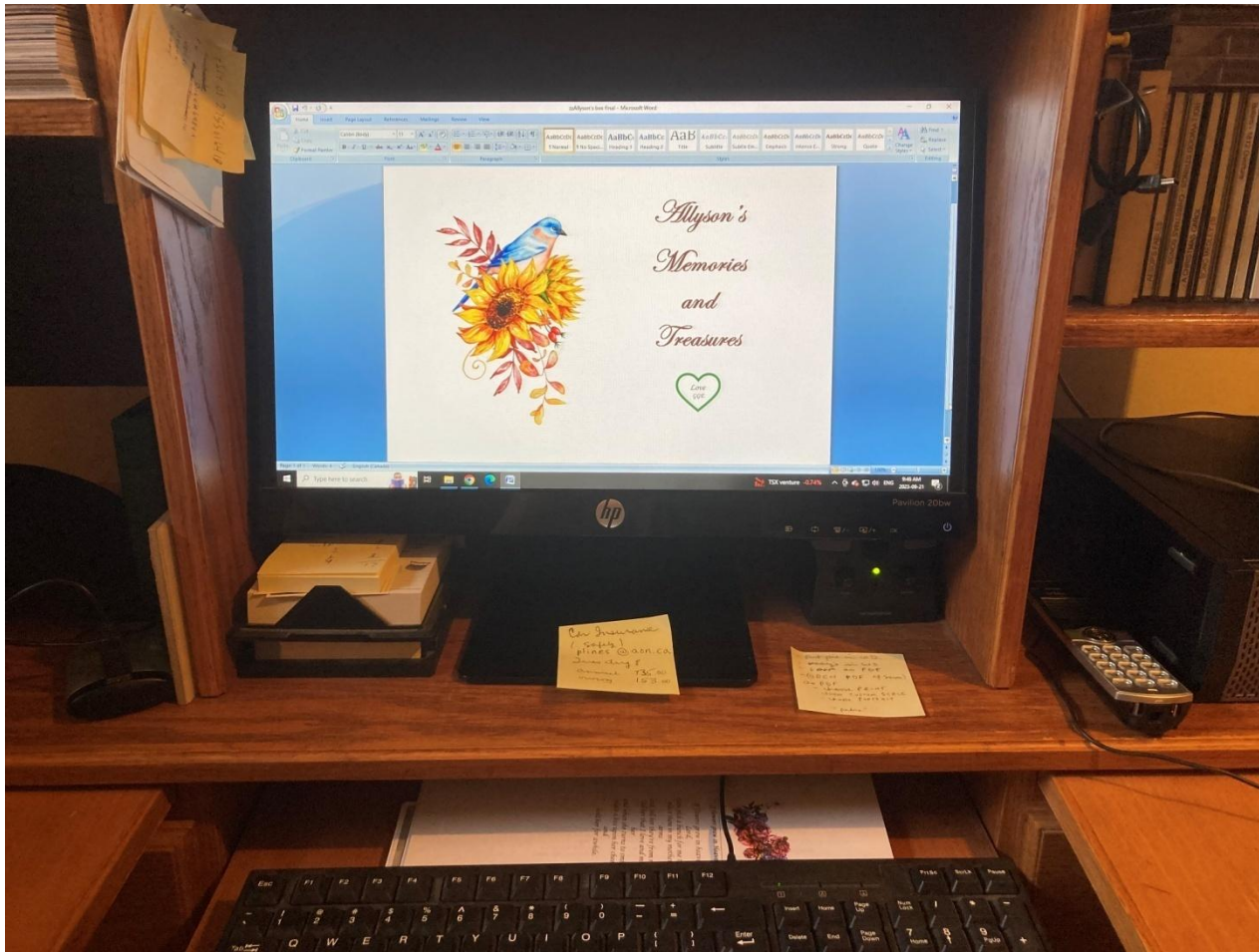
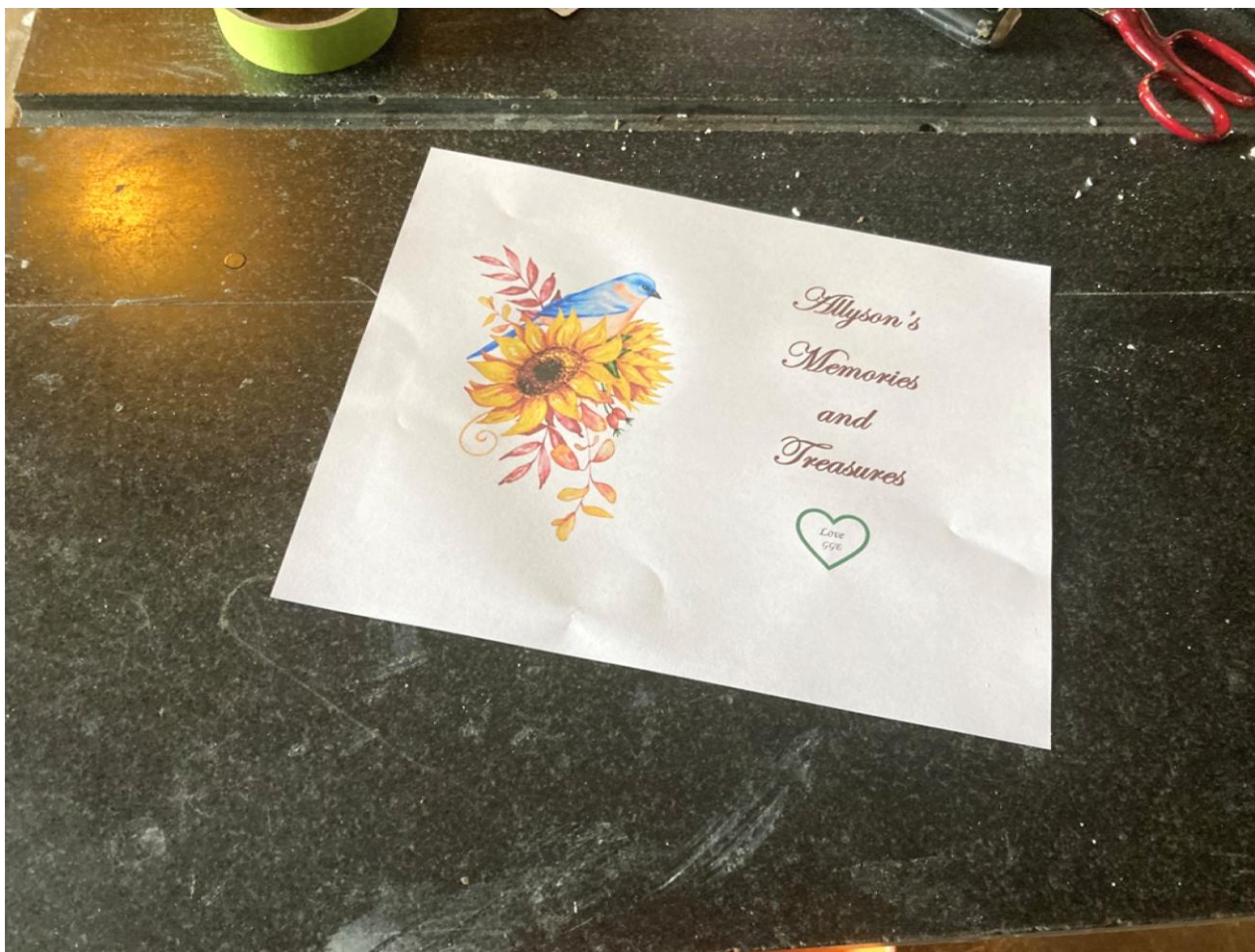


# Mounting Pictures Using Two Part Epoxy

# Printed picture

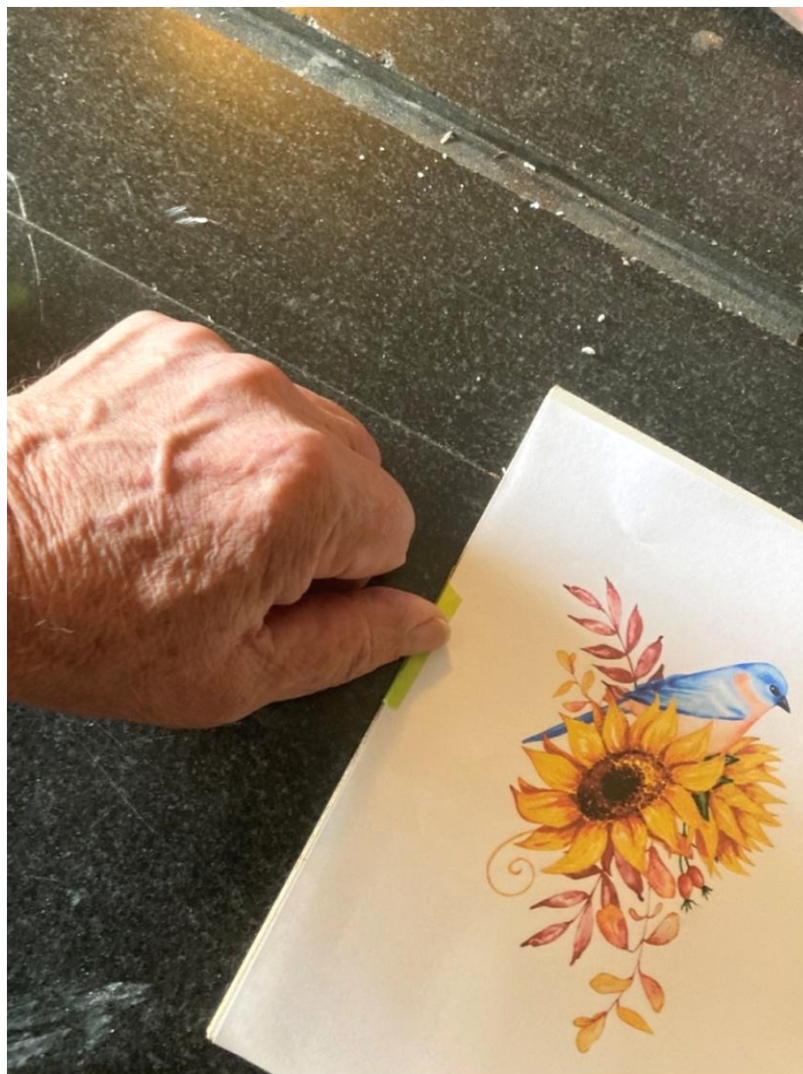


Picture ready to be glued onto ¼" white hardboard

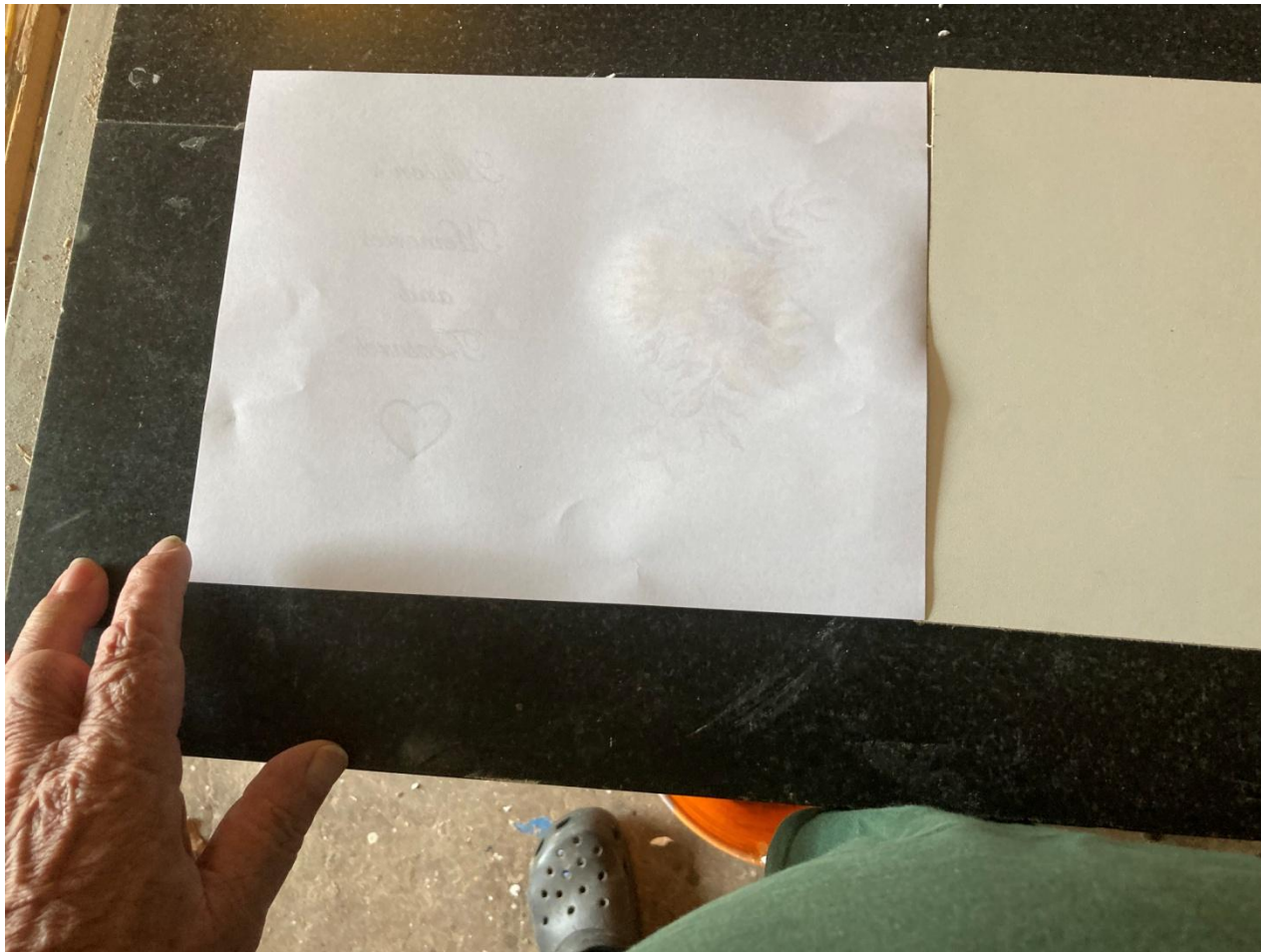




Taping edge of picture to position it before gluing

# Checking alignment



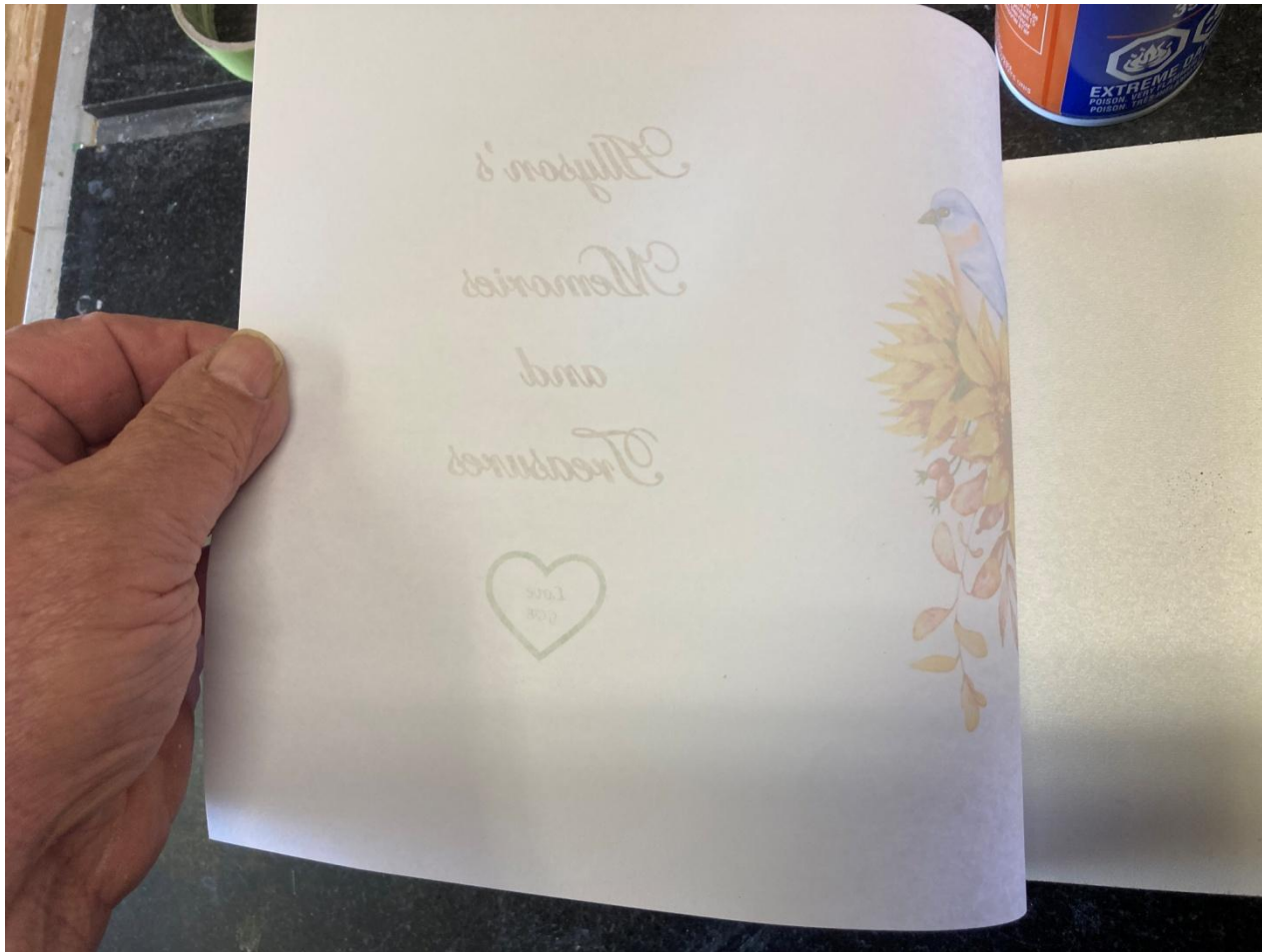


## Spraying with contact glue

Folding over tape to take care of epoxy drips

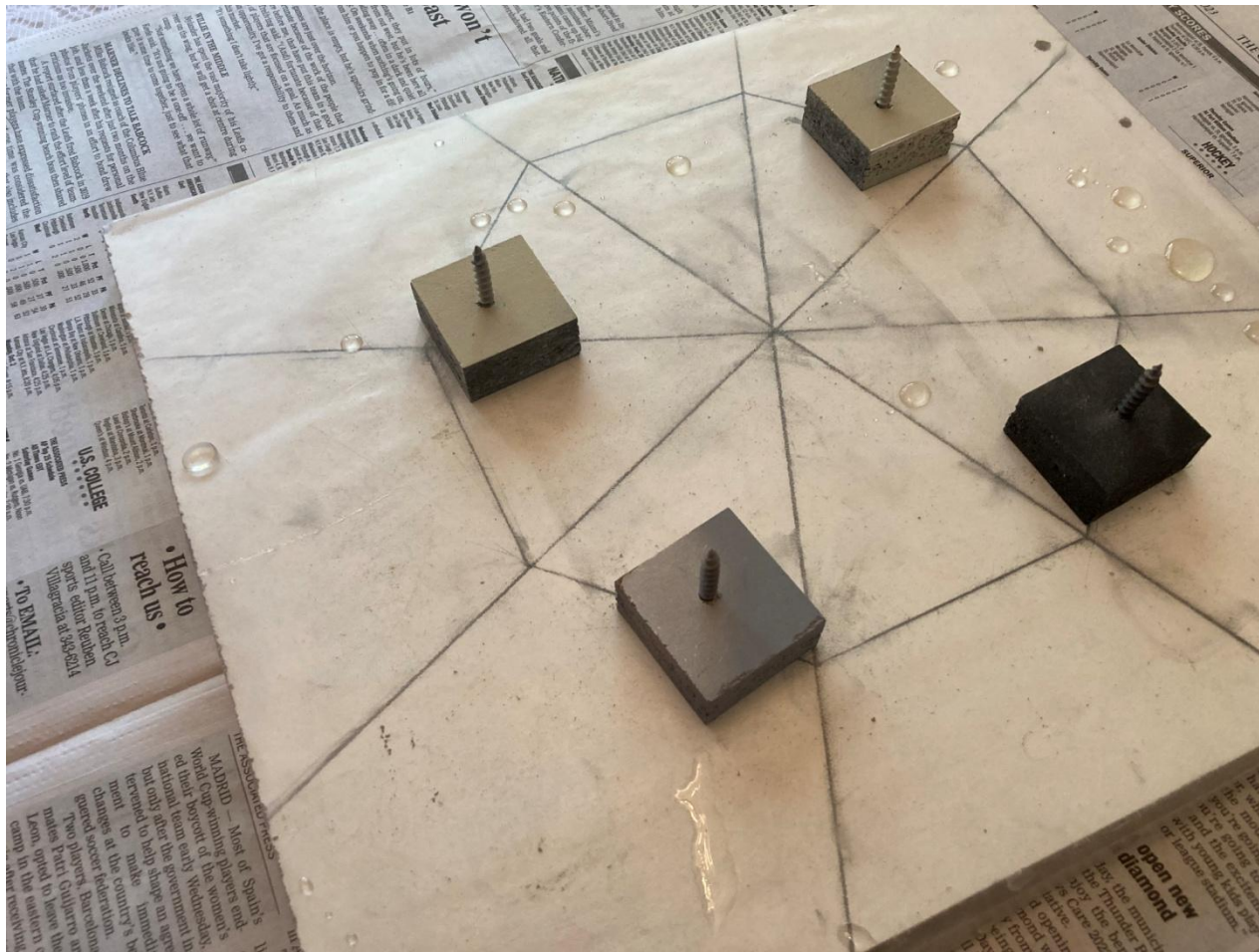




“Work table” covered with waxpaper
